It is with deep regret that I announce the passing of Real Daughter Cora Lee Jackson of Washington, D.C. on February 7, 2014. Cora Lee Jackson was born on June 20, 1919, the 14th child of Pvt. Alonzo Johnson of Co. F 45th Regiment Infantry USCT, which was part of the 25th Corps. Pvt. Johnson saw service in the final Campaigns of the Civil War, and was present at Appomattox Court House on April 9, 1865.

Wife of the late William Jackson, she is survived by five sons and seven daughters. Her nephew, Brother Ricardo Johnson, is a member of Lincoln – Cushing Camp No. 2, Department of the Chesapeake.
