AUXILIARY TO SONS OF UNION VETERANS OF THE CIVIL WAR

Passing of Real Son John Wilson Oliver Jr.

By the authority vested in me as National President of the Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, and the National Constitution, Rules and Regulations, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1: It is with deepest sympathy and sadness to report the death of Real Son John Wilson Oliver Jr. on Monday 15 November 2021 at the age of 96 years. He lived in Morristown, Tennessee and was a member of the Major William Anderson McTeer Camp 39 of the Department of Tennessee.

Section 2: Brother Oliver's father, John Wilson Oliver Sr., was mustered into service into Company F, 4th Tennessee Infantry as a private. This company was later re-organized and renamed the 1st Tennessee Cavalry. John Wilson Oliver Sr. was honorably discharged from the military on August 2, 1865. Brother Oliver was preceded in death by his parents and sister.

Section 3: The Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War extends its sincere condolences to all those who knew John Wilson Oliver Jr.

The foregoing General Order is proclaimed this third day of January, in the year of our Lord two thousand and twenty-two, and of the Independence of the United States of America the two hundred and forty-seventh, in the City of St. Robert, County of Pulaski, State of Missouri.
