Sectarian/Partisan Topics and Social Media

By the authority vested in me as National President of the Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, and the National Constitution, Rules and Regulations, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1: All ASUVCW members are reminded that the National Constitution, Rules and Regulations, Chapter I, Article V specify that the Order is "strictly non-sectarian and non-partisan" and that the "introduction or discussion of sectarian or partisan topics is strictly prohibited in any of its bodies." This includes Auxiliary meetings, communications and social media postings.

Section 2: The Order's official Facebook page is not to be used for posting personal beliefs and/or values. The Facebook page was established to provide a format to share Auxiliary activities, projects and ideas for the benefit of all members.

<u>Section 3</u>: Members may express their personal views on their own Facebook page, Twitter account, or other social media. Members shall not present their personal views as representing the views of the ASUVCW nor shall they present themselves as a spokesperson for the ASUVCW.

<u>Section 4</u>: Any member found violating the above-referenced section of the Constitution, Rules and Regulations may be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 5: The National President is the spokesperson for the ASUVCW.

The foregoing General Order is proclaimed this thirteenth day of September, in the year of our Lord two thousand seventeen, and of the Independence of the United States of America the two hundred and forty-second, in the city of Alliance, County of Stark, State of Ohio.
