

SPECIAL GENERAL ORDER NO. 3 SERIES 2017-2018 Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War

Passing of Real Daughter Patricia Albertson

By the authority vested in me as National President of the Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, and the National Constitution, Rules and Regulations, it is hereby ordered as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: It is with deepest regret that I report the death of Real Daughter Patricia Quinlan Albertson of Kalamazoo, Michigan on May 30, 2018 at the age of 95 years.

<u>Section 2</u>: Patricia was born on May 2, 1923 in Cleveland, Ohio to Mary Maxine (Hartnett) and James Webster Hadlock. Her father served nearly three years in Company G, 10th Vermont Infantry and was wounded in Virginia at the battles of The Wilderness and Spotsylvania Court House.

Section 3: Patricia was preceded in death by her husband, Eugene R. Albertson, and is survived by her four children: Sharon, Timothy, Patricia Louise, and Joseph Albertson.

<u>Section 4</u>: The Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War extends its sincere condolences to Patricia's family and friends.

Section 5: All Charters are to be draped in black for a period of thirty (30) days.

<u>Section 6</u>: All Sisters are respectfully directed to attach a black mourning ribbon to their membership badge for a period of thirty (30) days.
