Passing of Brother Henry Shaw

By the authority vested in me as National President of the Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War and the National Constitution, Rules and Regulations, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1: It is with deepest sympathy that the death of Brother Brigadier General Henry E. Shaw Jr. of the Sons of Veterans Reserve has been reported. Brother Shaw passed away on Sunday, 16 October 2022, at the age of 84.

Section 2: Brother Shaw was born on 24 August 1938 in Latrobe, Pennsylvania, to Henry and Marjorie Shaw. He worked in Delaware County as a Prosecuting Attorney and later as a Judge of the Common Pleas Court, General Division. He is survived by his wife, Sharon Trout, his daughter, Jennifer Gams, and two grandchildren.

Section 3: Brother Shaw was a life member of Sergeant Richard Enderlin Camp #73 of the Department of Ohio, SUVCW. He was a Past Commander of both his Camp and Department. He additionally served as the Deputy Commander of the SVR and offered mentorship to many Past Commanders in Chief of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War. He was well known for his legal guidance within the Allied Orders, as well as organizing the Gettysburg Remembrance Day Ball.

Section 4: The Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War extends its sincere condolences to all those who knew Brother Henry E.
