Passing of ASUVCW Past National President Faye Carlisle Thomas

By the authority vested in me as National President of Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War (ASUVCW), and the National Constitution, Rules, and Regulations, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1: It is with deep sadness that I report the passing of Faye Carlisle Thomas, PNP and Navy Veteran. Faye Carlisle Roberts, of Cogan Station, PA, passed away on May 3rd, 2026.

Section 2: Sister Faye joined Auxiliary 44 in October 1966, under her great-grandfather, Private Adolphus Suttor, Company 143rd Infantry, New York. She later served as National President in 2002 with dignity and wisdom. She shared her knowledge and leadership expertise to shape PNPs who followed in her footsteps, as well as **to** guide the National Order.

Section 3: The National Organization extends its deepest condolences to PNP Faye Carlisle Thomas' family and friends—especially to her daughter PNP Cynthia Fox (2006).

Section 4: In solemn recognition of her dedicated service to our Country and Organization, the Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War deems that all charters of each Department and Auxiliary be draped in Black for a period of 30 days. All sisters are to attach a black mourning ribbon to their badge in remembrance of PNP Faye Carlisle Thomas from the date of this Special Order.
