Recommendation #4 - Recommendation on requirements of ASUVCW Scholarship

Due to the limited sources of funds, the scholarship needs to address providing our membership the ability to obtain the scholarship. We no longer can afford funds to be given to non-members that have participated in the principles of the Order. Hopefully this will demonstrate our intention on building a stronger member that may become a future leader of our organizations.

RECOMMENDED NEW REQUIREMENTS:

Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War Scholarship Application

The Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, founded in 1883 believes in the education of our young members by providing a scholarship to undergraduates to further their education that open the door to knowledge. This is an effective means for the applicant to reach their full potential. This is an investment in our future leaders and society. The ASUVCW may provide a scholarship -up to \$1,000 Dollars to an Auxiliary member or Son per year. Applicants must meet all requirements by April 15th of the year of applying for the scholarship to be considered. The scholarship is a one-time award to the selected applicant, not renewable.

Requirements:

1. Must be an **active member of the Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War or Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War for at least one year** prior to application.
2. Be accepted by an accredited College or Trade School.
3. Provide most current official school transcript (sealed)
4. Write an Essay on True Patriotism in 500 words or less
5. Provide at least two Letters of Recommendation sealed.
6. Send the entire requirements in one package prior to the April 15th deadline.
7. Must include a photocopy of her or his current membership and be in good standing.

If accepted, the funds will be sent to the School's Bursar's office, not to the individual.

The selection may be conducted by a Scholarship Committee of at least three Auxiliary members. Final section will be the President of the Auxiliary.
