Please accept this letter of intent for my candidacy for the office of Auxiliary to Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War (ASUVCW) National Chaplain.

At the 2023 National Encampment, I was honored to appointed National Chief of Staff. I spent the year developing and growing our local Auxiliary, and doing my duties as National Chief of Staff. My fundraising project partnered with Wreaths Across America. I raised \$4998 in funds for the Order. As important, Shiloh National Military Park Cemetery had a commitment of >1150 wreaths for 2024 and we hit my personal goal of 1500 wreaths in December 2025. In keeping with America's Semiquincentennial, our goal for 2026 is 1776 wreaths and we are likely to meet or surpass this. Last year funds raised for our National Auxiliary were used to offset the costs of the new Auxiliary Embroidered Crests for flags.
